Job Description:

Our growing homeschool is expanding, and we are prayerfully seeking a dedicated tutor to lead **Middle School and High School History** classes for the upcoming 2026/2027 school year.

- **Subject (Middle School):** History is a bridge between elementary social studies and high school history; covering foundational topics such as ancient civilizations, world cultures, early American history, geography, timelines, and key events with real-world examples.
- **Subject (High School):** History covering world history from ancient times to the modern era, United States history, government and civics, historical analysis, primary-source research, essay writing, and critical thinking, etc.
- **Format:** Small group instruction (aiming for 6–12 students per level) with teaching, interactive examples, practice activities, homework review, and encouragement in a supportive, Christ-centered environment.
- **Semester:** 14 weeks per semester, starting around late-August 2026 to May 2027
- **Schedule:** (2) 1.5-hour classes (e.g., one class for Middle School and one for High School)
- **Location:** Class meets on church premises.

Key Responsibilities:

- Schedule and lead weekly classes for each level, maintaining a consistent 14-week semester structure from late August 2026 to May 2027.
- Assess student progress, provide feedback, and adapt teaching methods to meet individual needs while fostering a passion for History rooted in faith.
- Collaborate with the Associate Pastor and Revival Homeschool team to align classes with overall program goals and integrate biblical principles where appropriate.
- Manage classroom resources, including procuring necessary supplies for experiments, and maintain a positive, team-oriented approach to support the homeschool community's mission.

Qualifications:

- Passion for History education, experience teaching middle/high school-level History (preferred: teaching credential or proven homeschool tutoring success).
- Ability to integrate a biblical worldview where appropriate (e.g., seeing God's design in creation).
- Strong communication skills, both written and verbal.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
